Cedric Herbert Barrow was born on 27th february 1926. His parents were Herbert & Elsie Dora Barrow. He was the eldest of three brothers; Norman (born 1929) & Raymond (born 1933). He was a member of Brighton Boys Brigade - a youth group which taught Drill, bible class, PE & had a band, they went camping in the nearby village of Glynde. As a result of the war Cedric was 'called up' into the army in August 1944 aged 18yrs, his rank was a private in the Royal Hampshire regiment 7th battalion. After completing his basic training, Cedric was deployed to Holland where he was killed in action on 22 November 1944.
